Since then, they have been working on ambitious multi-media projects exploring key issues including environmental sustainability and social interaction. They began the research project 70% The Mea/ in 1997, giving birth to a series of large-scale dining events across the world. Fabulae Naturae was the latest meal in this series, taking place at the Ermenegildo Zegna Headquarters in Milan on 2nd May 2015.

Curated by Maria Luisa Frisa, *Fabulae Naturae* is a multisensory performance teaming music, fantastical visuals and food to create an immersive whole. Chef Davide Oldani was commissioned to cook sustainable delicacies for the performance, helping Lucy + Jorge Orta deepen their artistic exploration of food and its pertinence to themes such as energy, life, taste and community.

The artists transformed the Zegna Headquarters into a paradisical forest, inspired by Lucy Orta's exploration of the Zegna archives, a collection of some 2,200 volumes of printed fabrics housed in Trivero.
